ANNUAL MEETING

Mark your calendar for Tuesday, October 4th at 7pm in the Centennial Elementary school cafeteria for our 2016 annual meeting. We will be voting on two important issues, one of which is a dues increase. Over the past couple of years, many neighbors have requested a dues increase in an effort to keep up with repairs, as well as to accumulate savings for larger upkeep items. The BOD is proposing a \$200 dues increase to bring our annual dues to \$581. A change in dues requires **2/3 of the HOA** to vote in favor of the proposal to pass. The second item is a proposal to take the money in the Special Assessment Fund (about \$30,000) and either move it to the general account or return it to you, the members of the HOA as stated by the 2012 Special Assessment ballot. Where the money sits now, we can only use it for creek/trail repair. We would like to free up those funds so we can use them for other needs that arise. For instance, we would have liked to use it for the pool this year, but the funds are reserved for the creek and trail only. It is important to note that this proposal also requires 2/3 vote in favor to pass. You will receive your proposal, ballot, and proxy at the beginning of August, giving us 60 days to collect votes! PLEASE return your SIGNED ballots and proxies to the Steeplechase mailbox.

- Please do not throw tree limbs, grass clippings, or leaves into the street. It is against City code to put debris of any kind in the storm drainage system. Offenders can be fined. Place trash and recycling containers out of site when not out for weekly pick up.
- Please drive slowly in our neighborhood.
- Please do not park cars in the street long term (over 24hrs during the week or 72 hours on the weekend). Vehicles that are in disrepair or not currently tagged are not allowed in the street at any time. They can be towed and ticketed for code violations. In addition, trailers can never be parked in the street while not attached to a tow vehicle. Please do not park vehicles on the grass.
